Kata, Weapons Kata, Team Kata Rules

- 1. Scoring In ALL KATA divisions will be done on the "Better Then" system. Scores will be written down and posted at each ring, so that everyone can see where they ranked in each group.
- 2. Scoring in Open Hand Kata will be based on Intensity, Balance, Flow and Technique.
- 3. Judges with 9-years and younger may allow competitors to restart once in Open Hand Divisions.
- 4. Ties are settled in this order: Dropping the lowest score, calling competitors up and judges point to who they feel demonstrated better.
- 5. Music is allowed during Team Kata, but not required.
- 6. Scoring on weapons kata will include Use of Weapon, Intensity, Balance, Flow and Technique.
- 7. Mishandling of weapons results in disqualification. This includes dropping or injury to self or others.

Sparring Rules

- 1. Sparring is round robin style. Divisions may be split to speed the tournament up.
- 2. Competitors must wear foam dipped style gear, mouthguards and cups (boys). It is up to the center judge to confirm that the competitors have all necessary gear.
- 3. Gloves that do not cover the thumb and fingers, as well as foot gear that expose the toes are not allowed.
- 4. Points are awarded for:
 - a. Clean strikes to the groin, body (including kidneys) and Head (not face) using hands and/or feet. Judges must SEE point land not just hear it!
 - b. Lead hand to the body counts if the competitor has good technique and there is power behind it.
 - c. If the opponent is on the ground, a standing person may score with Hands Only for 3 seconds. Person on the ground may score with hands or feet during the same 3 seconds.
- 5. Points are not awarded for
 - a. Hammer fists to the top of the head. This has the potential to hurt the opponent.
 - b. Jousting is not a point.
 - c. No strikes to spine, legs (including Knees) or face.
 - d. Sweeps or Takedowns
- 6. Ties are settled in this order: Wins, Total Points, Who Beat Who, and finally least points.
- 7. One warning can be issued for excessive contact/ bad attitude.
- 8. A second call for (non-intentional) excessive contact/ bad attitude will result in a point to

the opponent.

- 9. Center Judge may disqualify a competitor if:
 - a. Competitor has received and lost a point for excessive contact/ attitude and now has received a third call for excessive contact/ bad attitude. (They are disqualified for current match)
 - b. Competitor has been disqualified from a previous match and continues to have calls for excessive contact/bad attitude in another match. (Competitor is disqualified from the Division)
 - c. Center judge can immediately disqualify a competitor, without warning, if they feel that the competitor is intentionally trying to hurt their opponent or if they display VERY poor sportsmanship. (Yelling, throwing gear, getting in people's faces)
 - d. Competitors can be disqualified if Parent/ Spectators are displaying unsportsmanship conduct. (Yelling, swearing, getting in people's faces)
